UCEBT staff have extensive training and experience in the treatment and management of a wide range of mental health difficulties ranging from common depression and anxiety to high risk behaviors such as suicidality. In addition to providing clinical services, many of our staff hold faculty appointments at the University of Utah and remain abreast of latest clinical developments.

Applicant: Psychologists, Clinical Social Workers, and CMHCs with specialty training consistent with one or more of our clinical teams are encouraged to apply. Interpersonal warmth, openness to feedback and commitment to continual learning are essential. The clinician will have the opportunity to see clients in the age range of their interest(s), including children, adolescents, and adults.

- Service as a clinical representative for an admin team to support the functioning and quality improvement of our Center
- Completion of charting in a timely manner
- Regular use of outcome assessments and responsive treatment planning
- Clinical Supervision of practicum students and/or postdoctoral fellows
- Fulfillment of on-site clinician hours to serve back up clinician consultation role
- Conduct that exemplifies UCEBT values of professionalism, collaboration, and compassionate care.
